Dear Sir,

Pursuant to Chapter 249:13, 249:15, 249:16, 249:17 and 249:18, Revised Statutes Annotated 1955, permission is requested to disturb the shoulders, ditches, embankments or the surface improved for travel. Installation to be as described below:

The maximum length to be opened at any time will be _____ linear feet.

Excavated material shall occupy not more than half of the pavement width. All in excess of this shall be hauled away.

Large diameter pipe is to be of permanent type. Pipe one inch or less in diameter shall be laid in a sleeve unless copper tubing is used. After the pipe has been installed the shoulder material must be replaced in layers, each layer being thoroughly tamped until the subsurface is thoroughly compacted and the top twelve (12") of trench will be of suitable gravel. All disturbed pavements must be replaced the same as it was before, or equivalent.

No detours permitted unless special permission is attached.

During the performance of this work, interruption of traffic must be kept at a minimum and the road shall be thoroughly protected by suitable barricades and flags during the daytime, and properly lighted at night. Where one line of traffic is in effect, adequate traffic control by flagmen will be required.

I hereby agree to make repairs or to assume costs for subsequent maintenance to pavement, shoulders, ditches, embankments, catch basins, culverts and storm sewers that are incurred by the settlement of back fill, for the ensuing two (2) years.

And I hereby agree to assume such additional costs as the Town may incur, by reason of my failure to perform this work in the manner prescribed above, and that I am familiar with the penalty imposed by Chapter 249:13 thru 249:18, RSA 1955.
