Commission members decided that, when describing plot sizes to new gardeners, it should be mentioned that plot sizes are approximate. The commission will not be taking any actions regarding plot size at the Community Garden at this time.

3b. Newsletter articles/"Interview with a Farmer" project: The submission for the winter newsletter article will be due on January 24, 2022. L. Cote asked the commission if anyone had suggestions for questions that should be asked or topics that could be covered in the interviews. L. Cote suggested asking farmers to summarize month by month what activities occur on their farm. P. Ford said that her goal with this project is to help people understand what goes into producing agricultural products, as many people don't understand the resources that go into the products that they consume. Commission members decided that it might be best to leave the interviews open ended and see what farmers want to share, and what they would like the public to know about what they do. L. Cote is planning to reach out to Josh Andrews from Governor Dale Farm, and will interview P. Ford as well.
