

SELECTMEN ORDINANCE

4-82

RELATIVE TO TRAFFICE CONTROL OF PUBLIC
STREET AND HIGHWAY WITHIN THE TOWN OF NORTH
HAMPTON

At a regular meeting of the Board of Selectmen of the Town of North Hampton, New Hampshire, held on the 13th day of Dec. 1982, and attended by a majority of the Board, the following Ordinance was adopted in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 41:11 and Sections VII and VIII of Chapter 47:17 of the New Hampshire Revised Statutes Annotated 1970, and any other applicable statutes of said State, or amendments thereto:

1. Any person or persons who shall sponsor or cause to be held, a social, commercial or charitable function within the Town of North Hampton, which will cause or is likely to cause the interruption of traffic which will constitute or is likely to constitute a hazard to the public safety, shall employ at his own expense one or more public officers as may be determined by the Police Chief to control said traffic or safety hazard.

2. Any persons working on or causing equipment to be placed on or near any street or highway within the Town of North Hampton as to constitute a traffic hazard or a danger to the public safety shall employ at his own expense one or more police officers as may be determined by the Police Chief to control said traffic or danger. This section shall not preclude the need for street opening permits and related documents when required.

3. Whomever shall violate this ordinance shall be guilty of a violation and subject to a fine not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100.00) a day for each day said violation exist.
