

Re: Large Gathering Permit Application
My Breast Cancer Support Motorcycle Ride 10/04/14

Based on the cooperation of Brenda Smith of My Breast Cancer Support during this event last year which also left from Seacoast Harley Davidson, I have no concerns in recommending to all the other department heads to move ahead with approval of this Fund Raising Ride again this year. The Applicant, Brenda Smith has already scheduled the required Detail Officer with a police cruiser in order to ensure there is a police officer with statutory authority to safely get what is estimated at approximately 300 motorcycles out of Seacoast Harley Davidson, on to Route One, all of which will proceed directly into Hampton. My approval of this Large Assembly is based on the conditions set forth below:

- Under no circumstances will police motorcycles or any other type of emergency vehicles from any jurisdiction be permitted to utilize any type of emergency equipment (blue lights, red lights, sirens, etc.) in the Town of North Hampton for this motorcycle ride or any other motorcycle ride within the town of North Hampton. There is no justification whatsoever under Mutual Aid for me to allow this practice. Any Police Officer, to include Fire Officers with fire trucks from outside the town of North Hampton risk being charged with Disorderly Conduct and/or Impeding Traffic for doing so;
- That under no circumstances will any road captain, police officer, civilian, Club President, Sergeant at Arms, or any other rider or participant involved in or in the

vicinity of this event be permitted to conduct traffic control at any intersection or upon any roadway in North Hampton;

- That under no circumstances will any rider, participant, or police officer or fire officer from outside of North Hampton within or in the vicinity of this event violate any motor vehicle statute, which includes but is not limited to stop signs, lane control, riding two abreast, and red lights violations;
- In order to guarantee a safe exit from Seacoast Harley on Lafayette Road, MBCS has agreed to assuming detail expenses of hiring of one police officer and one police cruiser. This will ensure that none of the persons mentioned above will be tempted to take part in any of the prohibited acts and conditions of approval above.
