Item 1. Review of UNH Town Wide Economic Development Survey. Key findings include: (Summary Draft <u>UNH Draft Report</u>)

Route 1 IBR District

Most residents favor greater development in the IBR zone.

Most resident favor filling empty stores over new development.

Most residents favor a sewer system along Rout1 but not willing to suffer increased taxes to pay for it.

Most residents disapprove high density development that may go along with a sewer system

<u>Signage</u>

Most residents say it is very or somewhat easy to find local business signs and are in favor maintaining 'dark night-time sky'.

More than half the residents would approve brightly lit signs if they were turned off at 9:00 PM.

Economic Development

Residents would like to see reduced taxes as part of an economic development agenda.

Residents have a favorable opinion of locally owned stores and, especially, restaurants.

About half of the residents are in favor of hiring an economic development expert.

Recreation

Collaborating with other local towns is seen as a positive by a wide margin, especially as it regards the New Hampshire Greenway project.

Maintaining and increasing recreational opportunities is strongly supported.

Quality of Life

Maintaining North Hampton's rural atmosphere is important to most residents.

Nearly all residents and business owners say it is important to maintain aquifers, wetlands, forests and open spaces and to beautify Route 1.
