




Four detail officers with cruisers to be assigned to the event. Officers will begin the detail at Seacoast Harley and then be deployed to specific locations as determined by the supervisor. One officer will remain at Seacoast Harley to assist motorcycles from the parking lot onto the public way.

Detail officers must be from North Hampton Police Department or one of the recognized Mutual aid Departments. The event organizer must contact the North Hampton Police Department at least two weeks in advance of the event to arrange detail officers.

Minimum of one (1) Certified Emergency Technician on site. Any Detail EMT must be either a North Hampton Fire Rescue EMT or a privately hired EMT if no North Hampton Personnel are available. The event organizer must contact the North Hampton Fire Department at least two weeks in advance of the event to arrange for EMT coverage.

Any tents used for the event shall receive a place of assembly inspection. It is the responsibility of the event organizer to call the Fire Department to schedule the inspection.

Certificate of Insurance naming The Town of North Hampton as an insured must be on file prior to final approval.

The applicant must make notification and seek permission for the event through the NH Department of Transportation for activities on the state roads.

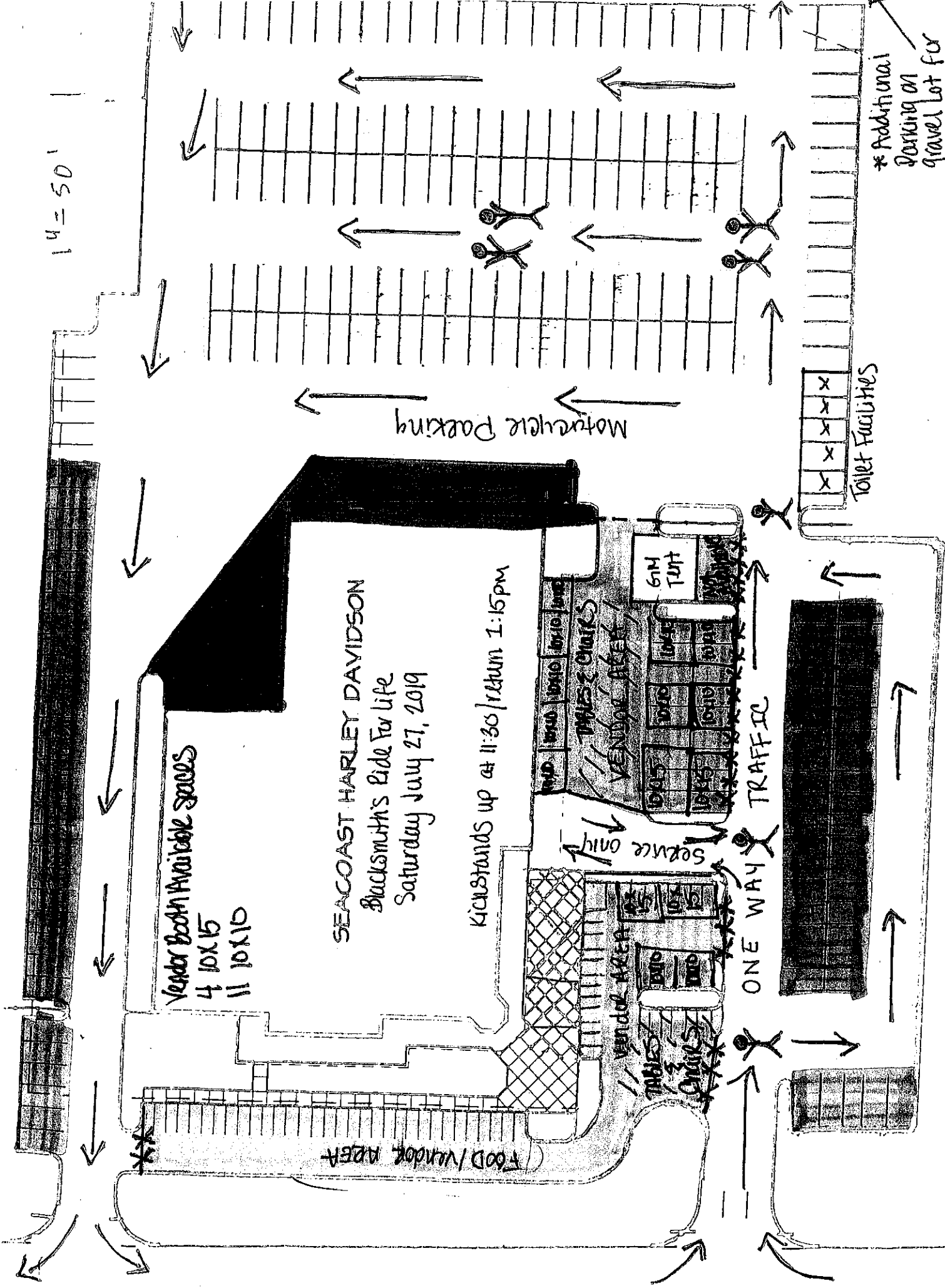

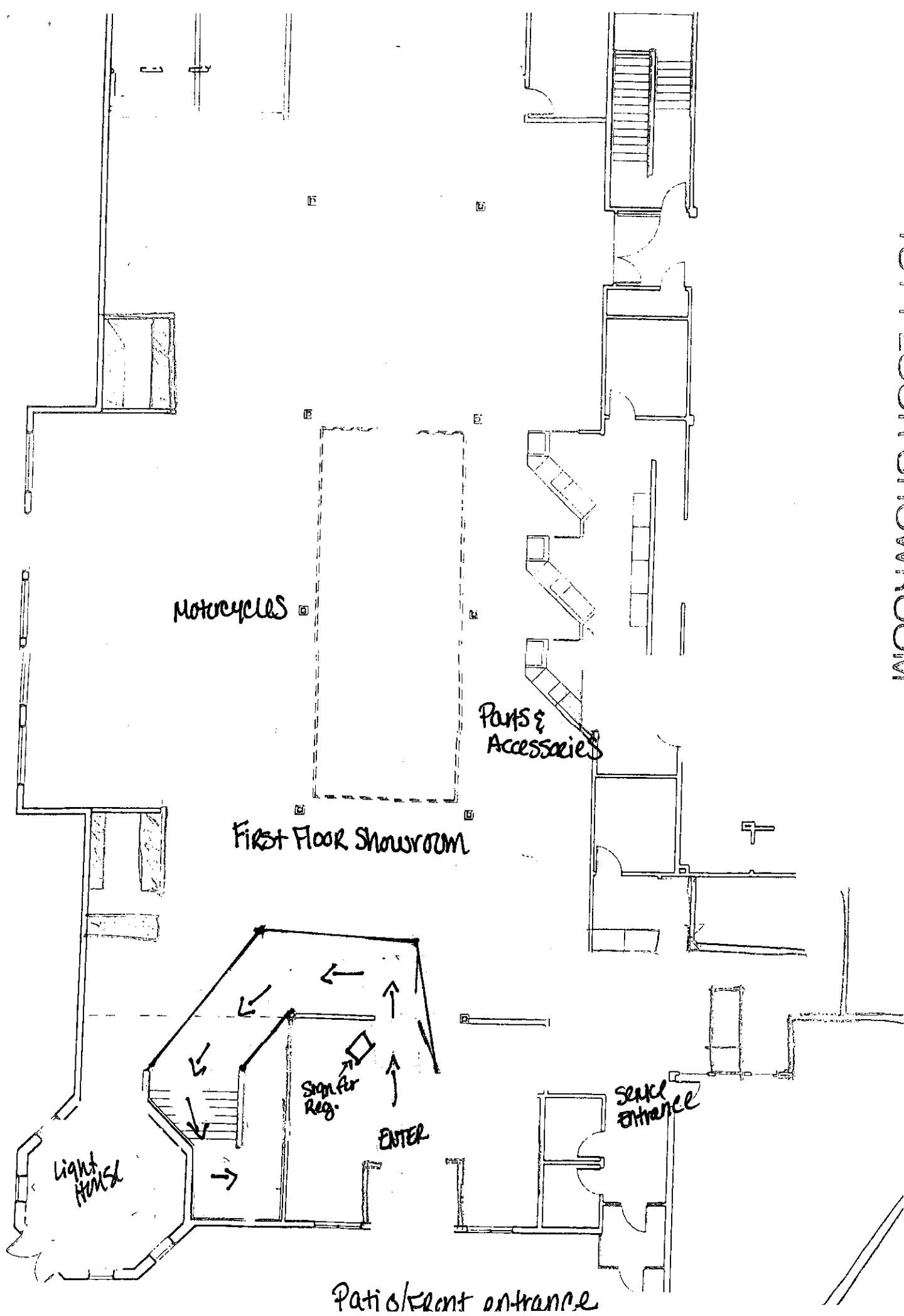

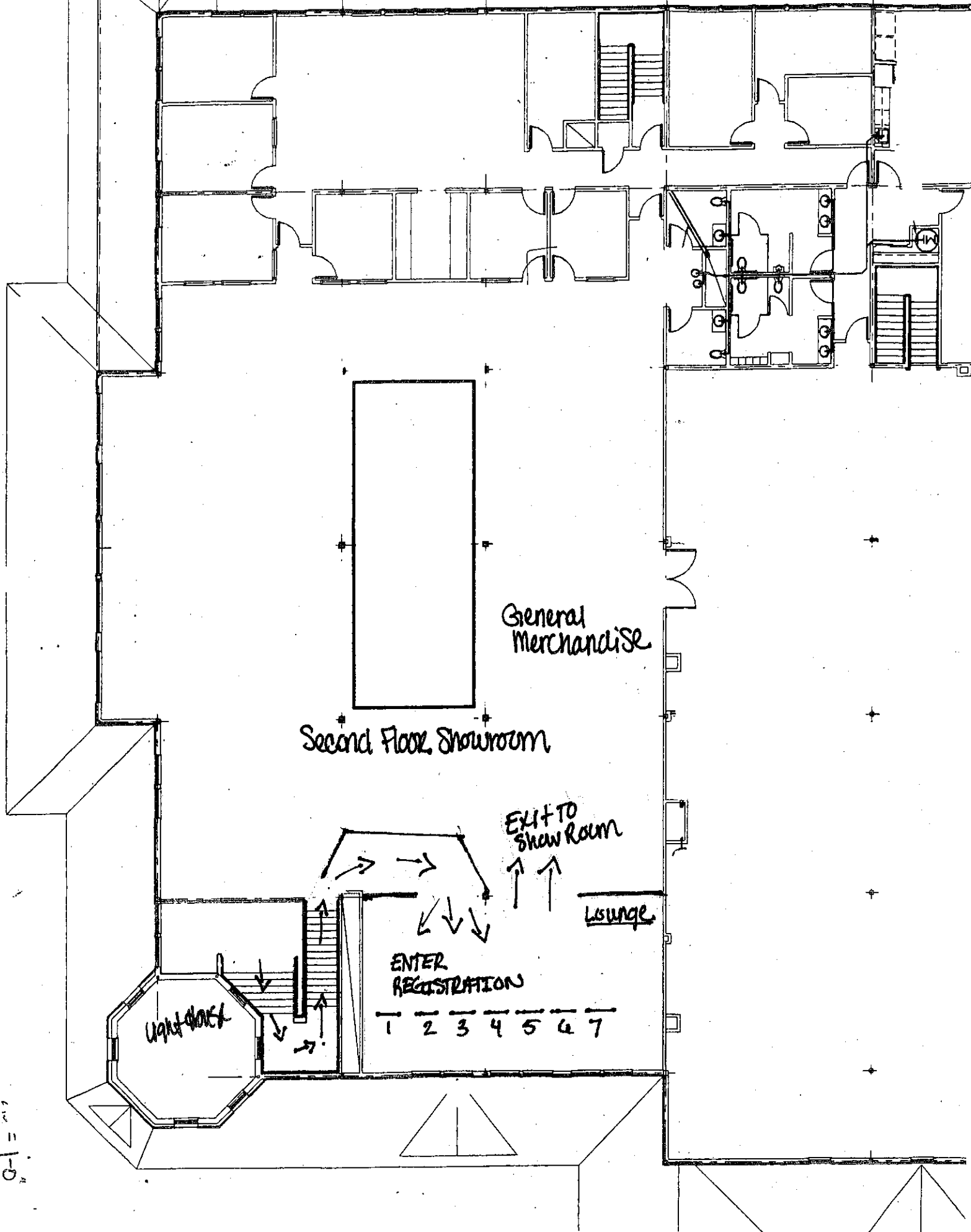

Good morning Jessica,

Thank you for following up with us on this event. There was a bit of miscommunication this year on our end and I do apologize for that. As always NHDOS approves of the motorcycle events and NHDOT advises of the route status. We have done a review and have found that we have two active construction projects along your planned route.

Both projects are repaving projects. The first is along NH 1 from the intersection Watsons Lane in Hampton to the intersection of Mirona Road in Portsmouth. The second is from the intersection of NH 1 and NH 151 in Hampton along NH 151 which turns into Newington Road near the Pease International Airport in Newington, the second part of this project is along Winnicutt Road from NH 151 in Hampton to NH 33 in Stratham.

The only obstacles along these routes would be "structures" - items such as raised manhole covers, raised catch basins, and exposed curbing. There also may be areas without painted lines. Your riders should be fine along these routes as long as they stay alert and monitor the roadway as they would normally do.

I hope this event goes smoothly and is fun for all involved.
