## Update-Press Release

### Report of Multiple Gun Shots Continues

**North Hampton (NH) –**

Investigation into the report of multiple gun shots being heard in the Birch Road area in the early morning hours of April 20<sup>th</sup> is continuing. Initial investigation reveals that one structure was hit, and a suspect has been identified. No one was injured, and police believe this to be an isolated incident.

Reports started coming in to the Rockingham Dispatch Center at about 2:05 AM. Responding officers heard shots being fired with the last one occurring around 3:25 AM. North Hampton Officers were assisted by the Seacoast Emergency Response Team, NH State Police, Greenland Police Department, Hampton Police Department, Stratham Police Department and Rye Police Department.

The investigation is on-going and police expect to make application for an arrest warrant this week.
