SELECTMEN'S ORDINANCE 2 - 84

SUBJECT: STOP SIGNS, NO PARKING SIGNS

The Selectmen have this day repositioned one STOP sign which is intended to stop traffic entering in a westerly direction from Chapel Road onto the extension of Maple Road, and

The Selectmen have this day erected a new STOP sign which is intended to stop traffic entering in an easterly direction from Maple Road onto Chapel Road, and

The Selectmen have this day authorised NO PARKING signs to be erected on Willow Ave, easterly side, from Swasey property (formerly Halsey property) to Fuller Property, and for a distance of 200' along the northerly side of Chapel Road where it enters Willow.

All the former restrictions, and penalties normally applying to STOP signs and NO PARKING signs in our Town apply to these also.
