

TOWN OF NORTH HAMPTON

Ordinance

Garage, Barn, and Yard Sales

- Section 1. **Sales:** It shall be unlawful for any resident of the Town of North Hampton to conduct more than two (2) garage, barn, or yard sales per calendar year. No such sales shall be held for more than three (3) consecutive days. There shall be a thirty-day (30) waiting period between sales. No merchandise shall be offered for sale unless it is the property of the permittee. The property owner shall obtain the permit.
- Section 2. **Permits:** No such sale shall be held without first obtaining a permit. Permits will be available at the North Hampton Police Department. A fee of \$5.00 will be imposed for each permit.
- Section 3. **Parking and Safety:** The permittee shall be responsible for controlling any parking and/or safety problems arising from the conduct of any sale. The North Hampton Police Department shall be empowered to determine if such problems exist or are likely to arise and shall make recommendations with regard thereto.
- Section 4. **Penalties:** Failure to obtain a permit will result in the closing of the sale by the North Hampton Police Department and any person holding such unauthorized sale be liable to a fine of fifty-dollars (\$50.00). Failure to comply with the recommendations of the North Hampton Police Department with reference to parking and/or safety conditions will result in revocation of the permit, closing of the sale, and the person holding the sale shall be liable to a fine of fifty-dollars (\$50.00).
- Section 4. **Takes Effect:** Ordinance passed by vote of Town Meeting March 14, 1978; amended and passed September 10, 1979; and amended and passed May 23, 1981.
