17		Chair Maggiore called the meeting to order at 9:36AM.

19		In attendance was James Sununu. Jonathan Pinette was absent.

21	2.	First Public Comment Session
22		Public Comment is an opportunity for residents to ask questions, request information and make comments

29	3.	<u>New Business</u>
30		3.1 Fiscal Year 2023 Budget Review
31		
32		Chief Mone gave an overview of the police department's budget proposal for FY23. She noted that the police
33		department is in the middle of labor negotiations so some numbers will change after that is completed.
34		
35		Chief Mone stated she would like to hire part time officers to help control over time costs. She also stated
36		she would like to increase the physicals line in order to allow for yearly mental health checks for each of the
37		officers.
38		
39		Chief Lajoie presented the fire department budget to the board. He stated there was an overall bottom line
40		increase of 7% with 6% in contractual increases.
41		
42		Chief Lajoie stated he would like to put the education line item of \$5,000 back into the budget.
43		
44		Emergency Management will see an increase in the training line, but the town is able to be reimbursed by the
45		State of NH.
46		
47		Director Hubbard stated that salt prices will be increasing between \$10 to \$20 per ton

- 48 Director Hubbard stated the asphalt and paving line item will be level funded. He further stated the cost of
 49 streetlights has come down due to LED lighting.
