- A. NH DES Wetlands Bureau: Expedited Minimum Impact Wetlands Permit Application: Prepared by CMA Engineers, 35 Bow St, Portsmouth, NH in collaboration with Northeast Wetlands Restoration, 17 Keay Road, Berwick, Maine for Robert and Mary Omberg, 7 Old Locke Road, North Hampton, NH (Map 5, Lot 23). This is a restoration project in North Hampton, NH adjacent to Chapel Brook and Philbrick Pond. The project will temporarily impact less than 20,700 square feet of wetland and permanently impact less than 6,100 square feet of wetland. The project aims to improve marsh drainage in order to enhance native plant re-colonization, as well as salt marsh drainage in order to enhance native plant re-colonization, as well as salt marsh functions and values. The project involves ditch remediation and micro-runnel restoration techniques to restore the Philbrick Pond salt marsh system. Strategies are proposed to address the presence of phragmites. The tentative schedule is for permitting to conclude in 2022 and field work to begin in spring of 2023.
