3a. <u>Community Garden</u>: A. Ryder and B. Clapp were in attendance to discuss the North Hampton Community Garden and the possible expansion. A. Prior gave a summary of the Agricultural Commission's discussion from the December 19th meeting, including that the expansion has been put on hold in order to address other issues. Concerns to be addressed include: shading from evergreen trees on the Community Garden property; mowing, and whether the town can commit to mowing certain areas around the outskirts of the garden; unmaintained plots; and, fencing. The Agricultural Commission will discuss in February whether a work day at the garden would be beneficial. This work day meeting would likely be scheduled for March.

A. Prior asked R. Perkins to attend the next meeting where the commission will be discussing goals for 2023 and deciding what projects to focus on this year.
