

North Hampton State Beach Parking Permit Requirements
Adopted by the North Hampton Select Board, March 28, 2022

The following requirements apply to purchasing beach parking permits:

- ❖ Residential property owners and those residents that lease or rent residential property in the Town of North Hampton may purchase a beach parking permit.
- ❖ North Hampton residential property owners who do not permanently reside in North Hampton must present a valid vehicle registration.
- ❖ Post Office Boxes are not sufficient to establish eligibility for a beach permit.
- ❖ Commercial plates are not eligible for beach parking permits.
- ❖ A registration for the vehicle on which the beach parking permit is to be affixed must be provided for each permit requested.
- ❖ All beach parking permits must be permanently affixed to assigned vehicles as indicated on the permit.
- ❖ Any alteration or transference of a beach parking permit to another vehicle other than the vehicle it was assigned to is a violation and is punishable by a \$100 fine in accordance with the North Hampton parking ordinance updated on July 11, 2011.

*Property owners is defined as any person(s) owning a residential dwelling/structure within the town.

**Residents are residential property owners living in their property or lessees with a year-round agreement or seasonal lease or are qualified to become a registered voter in North Hampton, and the North Hampton address is the legal address listed on the vehicle's registration.
