

## TOWN OF NORTH HAMPTON CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN COMMITTEE MINUTES

## REGULAR MEETING: JULY 27, 2018 8 A.M. MARY HERBERT ROOM NORTH HAMPTON TOWN OFFICES 233 ATLANTIC AVENUE NORTH HAMPTON, NEW HAMPSHIRE

Nancy Monaghan, the presiding officer, called the meeting to order at approximately 8 a.m. The following members were also present:

Chairwoman Monaghan began the meeting by presenting the minutes of July 20, 2018 for approval. The minutes were unanimously approved.

Public Works Director John Hubbard was then recognized for a presentation of his updated CIP plan for the Public Works Department. He began in year 2020 with a road improvement plan at a cost of \$250,000 as well as a reconstruction and repavement of the Town Office complex parking lot at a cost of \$90,000. In the year 2021 the road improvement plan comes to a cost of \$260,000 in addition to the replacement of a 1999 Case Backhoe at \$125,000. In the year 2022 the road improvement plan is figured at \$210,000 and equipment scheduled for replacement is a 2004 John Deere tractor at a cost of \$54,000. The year 2023 road improvement plan was presented at \$240,000 and replacement of a 2011 Ford pickup truck at \$75,000. The 2024 road improvement plan was presented at \$215,000 and the following year 2025 was figured at \$180,000.

The committee held a brief discussion regarding deficiencies in the flow of the Winnicut River beneath the Exeter and Lovering Road culverts. The committee unanimously endorsed the idea of Chairwoman Monaghan drafting a letter to the Conservation Commission outlining these issues and seeking to identify potential funding sources.

The meeting was adjourned at approximately 9:17AM.
