Mr. Gregoire and Andy Vorkink discussed a lot line adjustment that would provide Town access to the LRNC in exchange for the Town's relinquishing access from Mr. Gregoire's Mill Place property.

Kathy Grant and Phil Thayer will plan to walk the property on Sunday, July 15 at 8:00 a.m. to take photos and to better assess potential access from the southerly portion of the lot located on Map 6, Lot 79.
