- 3b. <u>Master plan goals:</u> The NHPL Landscape Advisory Committee has not had another meeting yet. A. Prior and L. Cote will provide updates.

The Agricultural Commission brochure is almost complete. Only one picture needs to be changed out. P. Ford offered to provide photos. A. Prior will incorporate the new photos and provide a final draft for review at the next meeting.

3c. <u>Land Use Boards Meeting</u>: Commission members discussed possible topics for discussion at the annual land use boards meeting. Suggestions included the Agricultural Soils maps, and current activities of the Agricultural Commission, such as the status of the Community Garden, working with the North Hampton Public Library on edible landscaping, and progress towards master plan goals. A. Prior will organize these into two to three points to be discussed at the land use boards meeting.
