Seniors: The senior December luncheon delivery was held 12/22/2020, with Joe delivering boxed meals prepared by Joe's. There were 2 100.00 donations given anonymously which was so appreciated. For the Thanksgiving dinner boxes there were 56 recipients.

Ski program update: To date 40 kids have signed up for the Gunstock discount provided by the Rec department.
