1. **Call to Order by the Chair**

Chair Maggiore called the meeting to order at 7:30AM. Those in attendance were Selectman Miller, Selectwoman Kilgore, Town Administrator Kaenrath, Fire Chief Tully and Rockingham Planning Consultant Jennifer Rowden.

2. **First Public Comment Session**

Public Comment is an opportunity for residents to ask questions, request information and make comments on issues facing the Town. Individuals will be given not more than three (3) minutes to speak, and people who have already spoken will be asked to wait until everyone has had the chance to speak once. The total time devoted to this agenda item is fifteen (15) minutes. Individuals who are not able to speak during the First Public Comment Session will be given first opportunity to speak during the Second Public Comment Session at the end of the Meeting.

3. **New Business**

3.1 2018 Hazard Mitigation Plan

Mrs. Rowden explained the Hazard Mitigation Plan must be filed every five years as required by FEMA in order to apply for any grants to help with costs caused by damage or loss.

Mrs. Rowden stated many town boards, departments and staff were involved in the preparation of the document.

Selectman Miller asked if the plan would cover Philbrick Pond should it flood, and Mrs. Rowden stated federal funds would cover it.

Chair Maggiore asked if Pond Path was covered as well and Mrs. Rowden stated it would be.
