Mr. Fuller called the meeting to order at 3:05 p.m.

Mr. Fuller moved to enter a non-public session to discusses legal matters under RSQ 91-A-3,II.e. Mr. Harned seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken and the motion passed 4-0.

Mr. Gearreald presented Hampton's findings regarding Aquarion earnings significantly exceeding the earnings approved by the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission. It appears that Aquarion's overearnings may exceed \$2,200,00.00 years 2013 to 2018. Mr. Gearreald requested the Water Commission join the Town of Hampton if filing a complaint with the Public Utilities Commission and request a refund to the rate payers.

The Water Commission also discussed with Mr. Gearreald Water Council appeal of the New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services order of a permanent connection of Wiggin Way to Aquarion.

A roll call vote was taken and the motion passed 4-0. Mr. Harned moved to seal the minutes of the non-public session. Mr. Fuller seconded the motion.
