The Large Gathering Application for the Throwback Thirsty Goblin 5K, October 29, 2022, is approved based on the following conditions:

- 1. Local businesses or organizations (to include the United Church of Christ of North Hampton) that may be affected by the race activities shall be notified at least two weeks prior to the event.
- 2. Parking must be on-site or at alternative sites as arranged by the organization (Timberland in Stratham has been pre-arranged). Under no circumstances will parking be allowed on Hobbs Road, Route 1/Lafayette Road, Elm Road, Birch Road, New Road, or Shepard's Lane. The shuttle busy may stop on Hobbs Road for the purpose of discharging or accepting passengers.
- 3. Volunteers shall not conduct traffic control at any intersection or upon any public way within the Town of North Hampton unless permission for such function is approved in advance by the Town of North Hampton.
- 4. Minimum of three (3) detail officers with cruisers to be assigned to the event. Detail officers must be from North Hampton Police Department of one of the recognized Mutual Aid Departments. The even organizer must contact the North Hampton Police Department at least two weeks in advance of the event to schedule the detail officers.
- 5. Minimum of one (1) certified Emergency Medical Technician on site. Any detail EMT must be a North Hampton Fire and Rescue EMT or privately hired EMT if no North Hampton Personnel are available. The event organizer must contact the North Hampton Fire Department at least two weeks in advance of the vent to arrange for EMT coverage.
- 6. The applicant must make notification and seek permission for the event through the New Hampshire Department of Transportation and activities on the state roads. Approval needs to be provided to the police department.

1. Certificate of Insurance naming the Town of North Hampton as an additional insured must be submitted to the Chief of Police prior to the event.

My name is Ashley Steeves, Founder and Owner of High5EM a race management company headquartered in Amesbury, MA. This is a request for permission to utilize the streets of North Hampton, NH on Saturday, Oct 29th to host the Inaugural Thirsty Goblin 5k run/walk in partnership with Throwback Brewery to benefit Seacoast Eat Local.

This Halloween themed run/walk will start and finish at Throwback Brewery starting at 10AM. You will find the route attached with a turn-by-turn description. We are not requesting any road closures and will work with the North Hampton PD for required police details. The first finisher will be done by 10:20AM and the last by 11AM.

All pre/post festivities will be held on the property of Throwback Brewery. There will be no outside vendors brough in and no tents larger than 10x10 setup on the property.

We're expecting around 200 participants at our first-time event. With approx. 85-90 parking spots available on site at Throwback Brewery this should be sufficient with the number of families expected to participate, but plan B for additional parking will be at Timberland in Stratham in case that is required.

Course Route: The race is a 5K counterclockwise loop around the back roads of North Hampton. The race starts at Throwback Brewery. Participants run off the property toward Elm Road along a driveway, turn left onto Elm Road. Runners turn left onto Bird Rd for 0.6 miles, turn left on North Rd, and run for 0.8 miles, turn left on Post Rd (Rte 151) and run 1 mile, turn left on Cross Street in front of United Church of Chris, then straight onto Hobbs Rd for 0.5 miles, turn left to finish in Throwback's driveway.

*There will be one 1 water stop setup at the Sagamore Golf Course which is approx. the ½ way mark on the course.





Pedestrians' Rights and Duties

Pedestrians Subject to Traffic Signs and Regulations. A pedestrian shall obey the instructions of any traffic sign or regulation specifically applicable to him, unless otherwise directed by a police officer. Pedestrians shall be subject to traffic and pedestrian control signals as provided in RSA 265:9 unless required by local ordinance to comply strictly with such signals. At all other places, pedestrians shall be accorded the privileges and shall be subject to the restriction stated in this chapter.

265:35 Pedestrian's Right of Way in Crosswalks.

- I. When traffic control signals are not in place or not in operation the driver of a vehicle shall yield the right of way, slowing down or stopping if need be to so yield, to a pedestrian crossing the roadway within a crosswalk when the pedestrian is upon the half of the roadway upon which the vehicle is traveling, or when the pedestrian is approaching so closely from the opposite half of the roadway as to be in danger.
- II. No pedestrian shall suddenly leave a curb or other place of safety and walk or run into the path of a vehicle which is so close as to constitute an immediate hazard.
- III. Paragraph I shall not apply under the conditions stated in RSA 265:36.
- IV. Whenever any vehicle is stopped at a marked crosswalk or at any unmarked crosswalk at an intersection to permit a pedestrian to cross the roadway, the driver of any other vehicle approaching from the rear shall not overtake and pass such stopped vehicle.

265:36 Crossing at Other Than Crosswalks.

- I. Every pedestrian crossing a roadway at any point other than within a marked crosswalk or within an unmarked crosswalk at an intersection shall yield the right of way to all vehicles upon the roadway.
- II. Any pedestrian crossing a roadway at a point where a pedestrian tunnel or overhead pedestrian crossing has been provided shall yield the right of way to all vehicles upon the roadway.
- III. Between adjacent intersections at which traffic control signals are in operation pedestrians shall not cross at any place except in a marked crosswalk.
- IV. No pedestrian shall cross a roadway intersection diagonally unless authorized by traffic control devices; and, when authorized to cross diagonally, pedestrians shall cross only in accordance with the official traffic control devices pertaining to such crossing movements.
- 265:37 Drivers to Exercise Due Care. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this chapter or the provisions of any local ordinance, every driver of a vehicle shall exercise due car to avoid colliding with any pedestrian or any person propelling a human-powered vehicle and shall give an andible signal when necessary and shall exercise proper precaution upon observing any child or any obviously confused, incapacitated or intoxicated person.
- 265:38 Pedestrians to Use Right Half of Crosswalks. Pedestrians shall move, whenever practicable upon the right half of crosswalks.

265:39 Pedestrians on Roadway.

- Where sidewalks are provided it shall be unlawful for any pedestrian to walk along and upon an adjacent roadway.
- II. Where a sidewalk is not available, any pedestrian walking along and upon a way shall walk only on a shoulder, as far as practicable from the edge of the roadway. Where neither a sidewalk nor a shoulder is available, any pedestrian walking along and upon a way shall walk as near as practicable to an outside edge of the roadway, and if on a two-way roadway, shall walk only on the left side of the roadway.
- III. Except as otherwise provided in this chapter, any pedestrian upon a roadway shall yield the right of way to all vehicles upon the roadway.

265:40 Pedestrians Soliciting Rides or Business.

- I. No person shall stand on the traveled portion of a roadway for the purpose of soliciting a ride, employment, business or contributions from the occupant of any vehicle.
- II. No person shall stand on or in proximity to the traveled portion of a street or way for the purpose of soliciting the watching or guarding of any vehicle while parked or about to be parked on a street or way.
- III. It shall be lawful for any person to hitchhike or solicit a ride from the occupant of any vehicle upon any road or way, or limited access road and highway provided that the individual is not, when so doing, standing on the paved portion of the road or way.
- IV. No person shall signal a moving vehicle or stop a vehicle on any public way in order to solicit or sell a ticket of admission to an entertainment or sports event.
