





PERMIT FOR THE DISPLAY OF FIREWORKS

Please Note the following:

All Permits must be submitted to the North Hampton Fire Department at least 15 business days **prior** to the intended date of display.

1.

Name of sponsoring organization or individual

Name and address of sponsor, owner or person in charge, if other than individual.

Intended date and time of display/rain date and time

5.

Name and address of person or company furnishing the display material

6.

Name of company issuing surety bond and amount of coverage (\$1,000,000 minimum)

7.

Name and address of operator(s) who will fire off the display

8.

The operator(s) certificate of competency number(s) and date of expiration. Copy to be attached.

9. The Town of North Hampton must be listed as an additional insured on the insurance. NH State Fire Marshall's **shall** be listed as a certificate holder.

10. Town of North Hampton permit fee of \$45.00 must be paid at the Town Offices.

11. Location where the display is to be held. PROVIDE PHYSICAL ADDRESS OF SITE. (Give location at which fireworks are to be discharged, location of all area buildings, highways and the lines behind which the audience will be retained and location of all nearby trees, telephone, or electrical power lines or other overhead obstructions.) ATTACH SITE PLAN.

12. The amount and description of the fireworks to be discharged, the number and diameter of the shells, and whether manually or electrically fired. (Actual shell count required for final approval).

- a) The sponsor of the display shall arrange for the presence of one, or more members of the local fire department as may be required by the Fire Chief. They shall be on duty from the time the fireworks are delivered at the site until the termination of the display and removal of all fireworks and debris from the site. For the purpose of this rule, debris shall include any unignited fireworks or remnants containing explosive material.
- b) The Fire Chief shall designate such fire extinguishing equipment as may be required at the display site from the time the fireworks are delivered at the site until the termination of the display and removal of all fireworks and debris from the site. The head of the fire department shall designate the location and type of fire extinguishing equipment.

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In accordance with the requirement of RSA 160-B:7111, I have reviewed the attached permit for display and have made the following determination:
