

Petition to North Hampton Board of Selectmen Pursuant to Article 12-a of NH Constitution

Whereas, all property owners are entitled to quiet enjoyment of their property;

Whereas, "No part of a person's property shall be taken by eminent domain and transferred, directly or indirectly, to another person if the taking is for the purpose of private development or other private use of the property."; (Article 12-a NH Constitution, Power to Take Property Limited.)

Whereas, all planning, zoning, and wetland approvals should be secured BEFORE forcing an easement on private property by eminent domain;

Whereas, eminent domain should always be the absolute last resort and to date it has not yet been proven to the public that all other locations and/or technologies have been exhausted;

Wherefore, Petitioners request that the Town of North Hampton's Board of Selectmen NOT APPROVE to take easements by eminent domain over private property known as 168 Mill Road, North Hampton, New Hampshire (Assessor's Map 012, Lot 052).
