

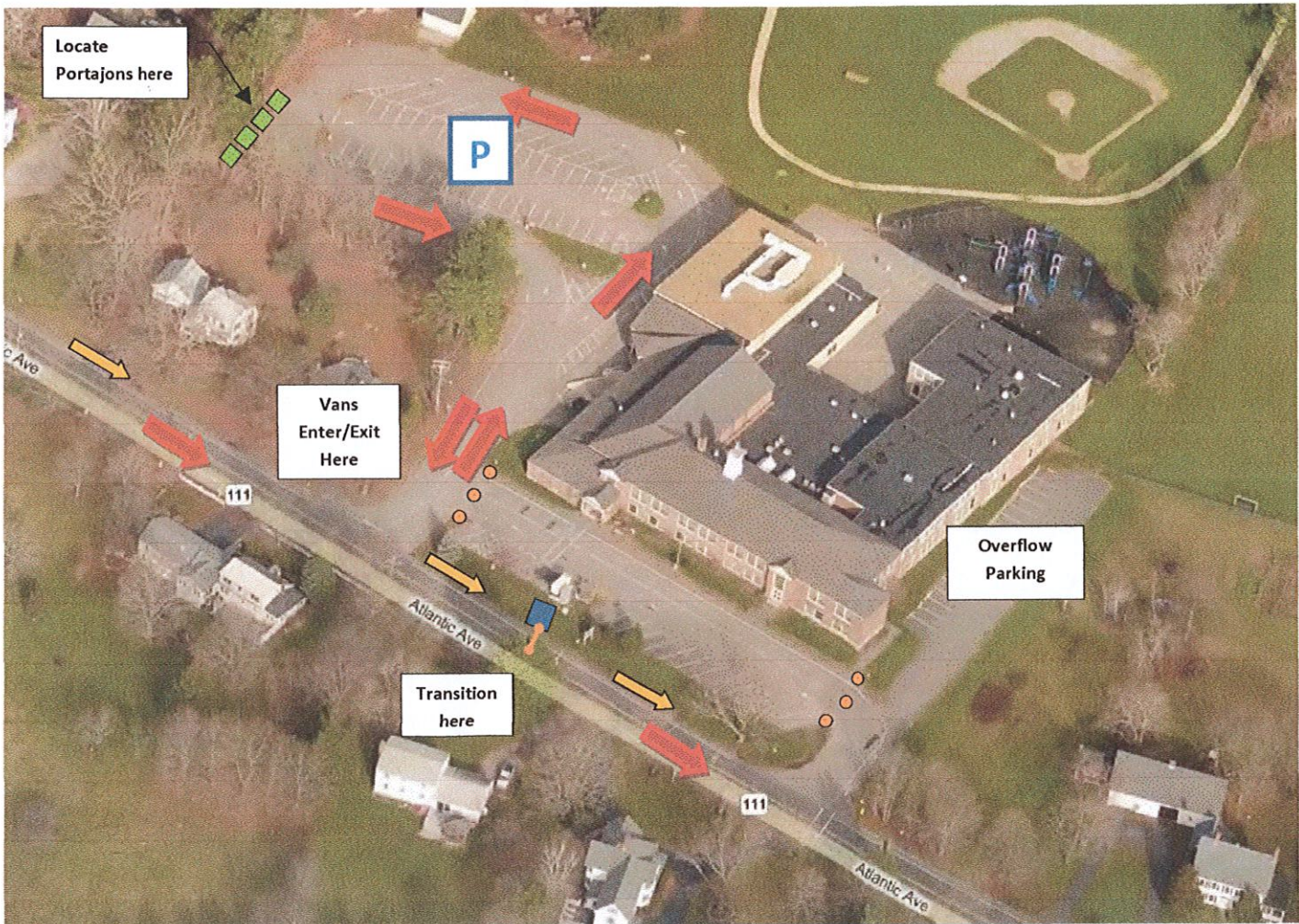

- Based on the annual plan I recommend again, one police detail at the intersection of Pine Road and Atlantic Avenue with a cruiser, and two detail police officers and one cruiser at the intersection of Atlantic Avenue and Lafayette Road. It is the responsibility of the organizer to call the police department at least two weeks in advance to schedule the detail.
- Parade Permit to be signed by the Police Chief and returned to John Dionne following the Department Head approvals of the assembly.
- Under no circumstances police motorcycles or any other type of emergency vehicle from any other jurisdiction be permitted to utilize any type of emergency equipment (blue lights, red lights, sirens, etc.) in the Town of North Hampton for this event.
- Under no circumstances will any volunteer be permitted to conduct traffic control at any intersection or upon any roadway in North Hampton.
- Have a Certificate of Liability Insurance naming the Town of North Hampton as additional insured and submit to the Chief of Police.

- I have placed my signature on the review section of the application, and if it is reviewed and approved by Code Enforcement, Public Works, and Fire and Rescue I will approve the gathering based on the conditions set forth and required and forward it to John Dionne.
