We are pleased to enclose the Warrant Petition for your consideration at the Warrant Hearing on January 9, 2017. We have submitted the petition with the requisite 25 resident/voter signatures based on the Workshop Presentation of January 4, 2017 presenting a proposed new facility of 18,700 SF to be located on property on US Route 1 Lafayette Road, North Hampton.

We look forward to the process and the Warrant Election to be held March 17, 2017 and am available to respond to any questions or provide additional information as required.

We the undersigned registered voters in the Town of North Hampton, Hereby petition the Select Board to include the following article on the 2017 Warrant:

To see if the Town of North Hampton will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Six Million, Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$6,250,000) for the design and construction of a new Municipal Safety Complex to house both Police and Fire/Rescue Departments; such sum to be raised through the issuance of bonds or notes under the Municipal Finance Act (RSA 33); and to authorize the Select Board to issue and negotiate such bonds or notes in accordance therewith and to determine the rate of interest thereon and the maturity and other terms thereof; and further, to raise by taxation and appropriate up to Two Hundred Ninety Six Thousand, Three Hundred, Forty Dollars (\$296,340) for the first year's payment on said bond. The Safety Complex shall be built on a newly purchased piece of property located at 349 Lafayette Road across from the Throwback Brewery, Map 13, Lot 68. Cost of the land is included in the total cost of the project. The tax impact to residence for this project will be \$0.30/\$1000 of property valuation. The total cost of this project with interest over a 30 year cycle is Eight Million, Eight Hundred Ninety Thousand, Two Hundred Twenty Dollars (\$8,890,220).
