



Re: Large Assembly Application

Loco Sports Smuttynose Rockfest Half Marathon – October 1, 2017 (Sunday)

- This is the fourth year of the new race route. All of the runners remain in the Town of Hampton, and North Hampton only experiences a detour that only affects Ocean Boulevard and Atlantic Avenue, and no through traffic to Hampton via Woodland Road. Loco Sports will have signage for detours displayed during the race. It is also important to note that the detours do not apply to residents or non-residents traversing within the Town of North Hampton. Town residents or non-residents who want to travel into Hampton will be limited to using Lafayette Road to do so during the hours of this race.
- Under no circumstances will any volunteer be permitted to conduct traffic control at any intersection or upon any roadway in North Hampton.
- There is a condition of a minimum requirement of three (3) police Detail Officers with three cruisers. Any Detail Officer must be either North Hampton Police officers or Mutual Aid officers called in and requested through my office. It is the responsibility of the organizer to call the police department at least two weeks in advance to schedule the details. The three locations of these police officers with cruisers will be as follows:
 - At the intersection of Ocean Boulevard (Rte. 1A) and Atlantic Avenue (Rte. 111) where a detour will be set up, preventing southbound through traffic on Ocean Boulevard to Hampton. This would insure the safe flow of traffic at the detour and reduce traffic

going south on Ocean Boulevard to those only wanting to get to the North Hampton State Beach area.

- Area of Ocean Boulevard (Rte. 1A) and Appledore Avenue at the North Hampton / Hampton town line, preventing southbound traffic on Ocean Boulevard from entering Hampton and preventing illegally parked vehicles.
- Area of Woodland Road and Rockrimmon Road at the North Hampton / Hampton town line to prevent through traffic by residents and non-residents from entering Hampton where there will be many runners using Woodland Road in Hampton to run this race and to prevent illegally parked vehicles.
 - The North Hampton detail officer on Woodland Road will receive instruction from Hampton Police when to shut down the road. The North Hampton detail officer will inform the other North Hampton detail officers to initiate their detail assignments.
- As per any State Parade Permit, "Road Race in Progress" signs must be posted in advance of the event, maintained during the event, and removed promptly following the completion of the event.
- Have a Certificate of Liability Insurance naming the Town of North Hampton as additional insured and submit to the Chief of Police.
- I have placed my signature on the review section of the application, and if it is reviewed and approved by Code Enforcement, Public Works, and Fire and Rescue I will approve the gathering based on the conditions set forth and required and forward it to Michael St. Laurent.
- Parade Permit to be signed by the Police Chief and returned to Michael St. Laurent following the Department Head approvals of the assembly.

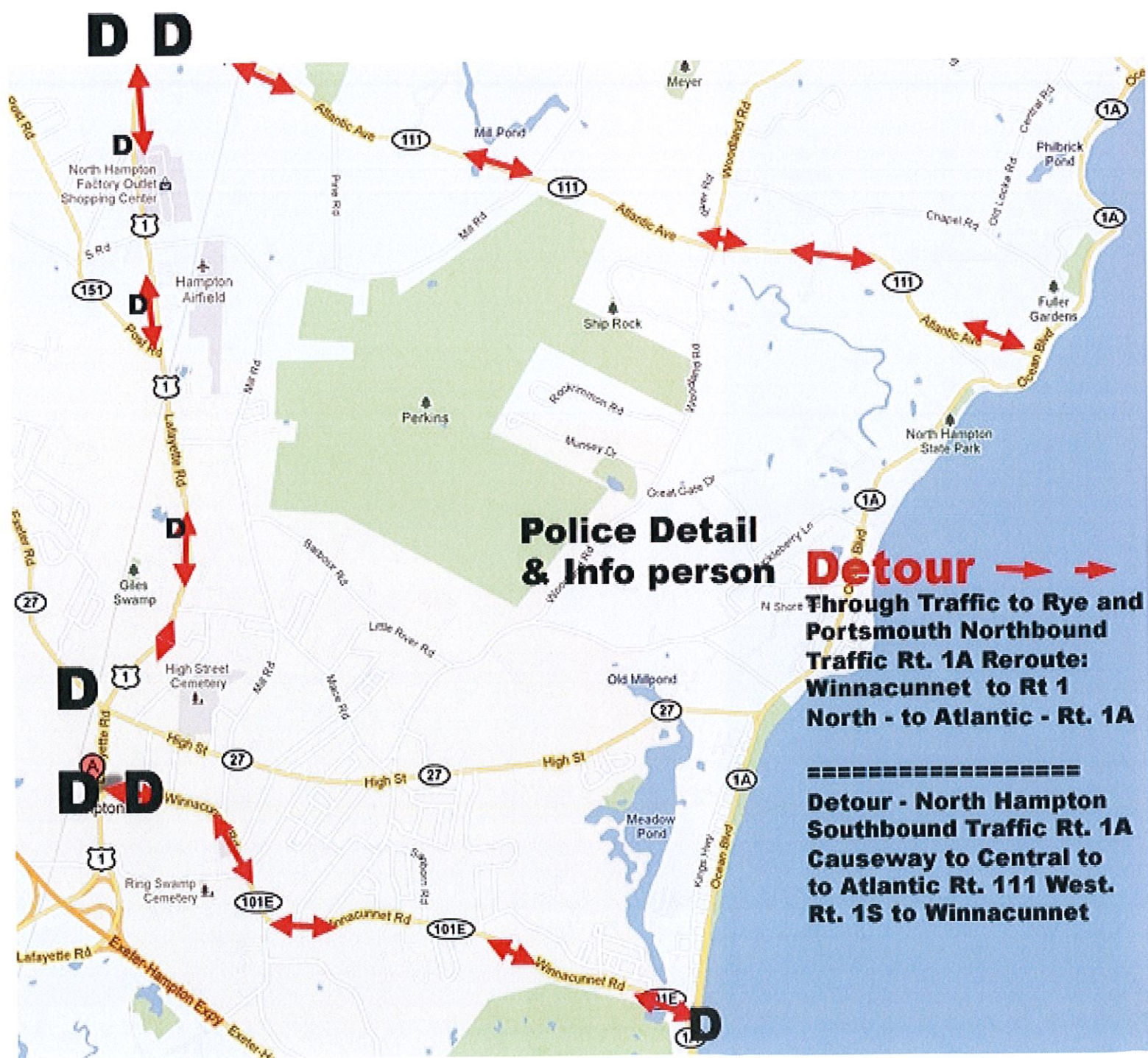
